

## **OPPOSE Huntington Beach Ordinance for Mandatory Spay/Neuter/MicroChipping Pet Animals**

I **OPPOSE** the proposed Huntington Beach Ordinance for Mandatory Spay/Neuter MicroChipping of Pet Animals in any form that mandates Sterilization (**CASTRATION/HYSTERECTOMY**) of any pet animal of any age thru local ordinance (**City or County**).

**The people of California vigorously opposed AB1634** when it was presented to the State Assembly and Senate and I think that it is an **insult** to all of California's registered voters when ANIMAL RIGHTS (CULTS) Activists attempt to pass similar measures City by City and County by County. **ANIMAL RIGHTS is not about the welfare of animals but the elimination of pets and all animal use.**

If **Los Angeles** is any example of what happens when broad scope mandatory pet sterilization (CASTRATION/HYSTERECTOMY) is passed, this will be a terrible financial burden to Huntington Beach. Since (2000) when **Los Angeles** enacted similar ordinances their animal licensing compliance has declined and their Animal Control budget has increased **269% from 6.7 MILLION Dollars to 18 MILLION DOLLARS to enforce.**

I **OPPOSE** the Huntington Beach Ordinance for Mandatory Spay/Neuter/MicroChipping of Pet Animals because I believe that **NO government should mandate serious, potentially life threatening surgical procedures**, namely the sterilization (**CASTRATION/OVARIOHYSTERECTOMY**) for either animals or humans.

**Medical procedures performed on either humans or animals should never be mandated by any government.**

To quote Lyndon Johnson, 36<sup>th</sup> President of the United States, "You should not examine legislation in the light of the benefits it will convey if properly administered, but in the light of the "wrong it would do and the harm it would cause if improperly administered."

Accordingly, as a registered voter and taxpaying citizen, **I respectfully ask that this ordinance either be withdrawn or defeated. I ask that you vote NO if this comes to a vote in any form that mandates the sterilization (CASTRATION/OVARIOHYSTERECTOMY) and MicroChipping of any pet animal.**
